Dear Member,

As you are aware since its inception, the Classic Register has attempted to operate within the confines of the Citroen Car Club of Victoria. However at the December meeting of the Register members voted on a motion to form a separate club. The motion was subsequently unanimously carried. It should be noted that the members present constituted over 60% of the Register financial members. As a result of this motion the committee has been investigating the avenues necessary for the formation of a new club.

The Register committee has decided, subject to Classic Register members' endorsement, that the new club's name shall be "The Citroën Classic Owners Club of Australia". The aims of the new club shall be as stated for the Classic Register. Eligibility for Full membership of the club shall be restricted to owners of Citroën vehicles of at least 20 years of age from the current financial year i.e. this year a 1958 or earlier Citroën is eligible. A category of Associate membership shall be available for all other owners. The committee is also considering the possibility of including special interest Citroëns of less than 20 years eligible for Full membership. Members views regarding this matter would be appreciated.

The committee feels that it is necessary to make a joining fee over and above the cost of membership to enable the new club to be quickly established financially and to cover the high initial costs in setting up the new club. Therefore the following rates will apply;

Joining fee - \$5.00  
Full Membership - \$15.00  
Associate Membership- \$10.00

However the committee also feels that some dispensation should be made for current Register members. Consequently any current Register member who joins the Citroën Classic Owners Club on or before March 2nd 1978 shall not be required to pay the joining fee of \$5.00. The new club's financial year shall begin on the 3rd March which coincides with the date of the release of the Traction Avant in 1934. Enclosed with this letter on a separate sheet is a membership form which must be completed and returned along with payment for those members wishing to join the new club.

The new club's constitution is reaching a draft form and it is anticipated that it will be ready for ratification by members at the inaugural meeting of the Citroën Classic Owners Club of Australia to be held on the 1st March 1978 following the Annual General Meeting of the Classic Register.
